

# 3M<sup>™</sup> Strip Holder 5012 and 5012-L

## Instructions

## 1.0 General

The  $3M^{\text{TM}}$  Strip Holders 5012 and 5012-L are used to provide cable and pole identification when used in conjunction with  $3M^{\text{TM}}$  Lettering Systems. Approximate size of the strip holders:  $5012 - 3.1" \ge 10.5"$  $5012-L - 3.1" \ge 15.9"$ 







## 2.0 Installation

- 2.1 Select the appropriate characters.
- 2.2 Using a 3M<sup>™</sup> Scotch-brite<sup>™</sup> Cleaning Pad 5008 (not included), scuff the shiny surface side of the strip holder.
- 2.3 Bend upper corner of number or letter to separate liner from adhesive.
- 2.4 Remove liner approximately half-way and fold or bend back.
- 2.5 Align character in the proper position. Contact upper portion of tab with the scuffed side of the strip holder. Remove remaining portion of liner and press tab into place. Repeat procedure to complete the lettering system.
- 2.6 Using a plastic squeegee, firmly press characters to surface.
- 2.7 For cable mounting, thread a black weather resistant cable tie (truck stock) through the two largest holes at both ends of strip holder as shown in Figure 1. Secure to the cable and snip off excessive tie length.
- 2.8 For pole mounting, nail the strip holder to the pole using the six holes on the outside edges as shown in Figure 2.



Inner holes and cable ties may also be used for mounting to cable.
